2. Workshop Description

Campus communities are grappling with Europe's colonial past and its cultural aftermath. Disciplinary protocols, which originated in this context, are being challenged as morally repugnant. We propose to bring together critical efforts underway in Lower Saxony (Leuphana University Lüneburg and Georg August University of Göttingen) and in Scotland (University of Edinburgh) for a cross-cultural conversation on distinct but related campus necrologies, that is to say traditions of thought with intended and unintended deadly consequences. Given the importance of the Scottish and German Enlightenments to the scholastic traditions informing university life, this is an opportunity to compare related interpretative practices in different situated contexts.
